

2026 marks ten years of Patrick Craig conducting Temenos. Patrick has chosen British music from the last 100 years, exploring different aspects of divine love, and featuring works of great beauty from Bairstow, Finzi and Leighton as well as newer heartfelt works by John Rutter, Bob Chilcott and Judith Weir.



Temenos is thrilled to welcome internationally acclaimed organist **Andrew Lumsden** for this celebration of heavenly love songs.

Music Director **Patrick Craig** is a countertenor, conductor and lecturer. He is a member of The Cardinal's Musick, and sang a thousand concerts with the Tallis Scholars. He is a Vicar Choral at St Paul's Cathedral, and founded *Aurora Nova*, the first all-female professional choir to regularly lead the services in the Cathedral. He teaches and directs choral workshops and courses across Europe, and lectures for the Arts Society.

Temenos was founded in 1988, developing from a specialist early music group into a choir which enjoys tackling chamber music of all periods.
